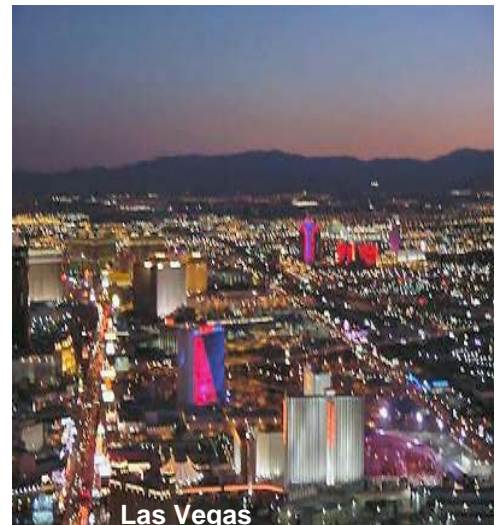

DAY 1 – Las Vegas-Mesquite: Travel to Las Vegas. After departing the airport, we will enjoy a short tour of the famous “Strip” in Las Vegas. We will then head out in a northeasterly direction to Mesquite, Nevada and check-in at the beautiful *Casablanca Resort Casino* (or similar). The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure to familiarize ourselves with our surroundings. Overnight with dinner at the hotel. (D)

DAY 2 – GRAND CANYON NATIONAL PARK: After breakfast, we will be visiting one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World - the vast and exciting Grand Canyon! Arriving at the Northern Rim, we will have a spectacular view of a wide area of the canyon and the Colorado River flowing through it. From Bright Angel Point, there will be incomparable photographic opportunities. We return to our hotel in Mesquite for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

DAY 3 – ZION NATIONAL PARK-MESQUITE: An early departure this morning, as we will depart for stunningly beautiful Zion National Park, a dramatic rugged gorge cut by the Virgin River through multicolored sandstone, limestone and shale and located near Springdale, Utah. From the floor of the canyon, we will marvel at the towering rock walls as we journey through this incredible natural wonder aboard an open-air bus. We will then return to Mesquite for a fabulous Western barbecue with chicken, ribs and all the fixings. Overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 4 – BRYCE CANYON NATIONAL PARK-KANAB: This morning we depart to travel to Bryce Canyon National Park for a full day tour. This park features some of the most colorful rocks that have been sculpted by erosion. The end results are called hoodoos. Iron oxides give red, yellow and brown tints to the limestone. Ruby’s Inn in Bryce Canyon will prove a perfect place for a serene lunch (*on our own*). After touring the park, we will motor over to Kanab, Utah – aka “Little Hollywood” for a Dutch Oven Dinner. Our local host, cook, cowboy and historian will share with us the history of the days when famous movie stars like John Wayne and Jimmy Stewart lived and worked in the area. Return to our hotel for overnight. (BB, D)

DAY 5 – ST. GEORGE: We will depart the hotel and cross into Utah for a visit to historical St. George, where we will be hosted on a tour of the local area, including the 1200-seat St. George Tabernacle, known as “the jewel of the desert”, and Brigham Young’s Winter Home, built in 1873. We will have lunch (*on our own*) while in St. George and have some free time to browse and shop. On our way back to Mesquite, we will stop at one of Utah’s most famous eateries – Chuck-A-Rama – for a delicious home-style meal. Overnight. (BB, D)

DAY 6 – VALLEY OF FIRE-LAKE MEAD-HOOVER DAM-LAS VEGAS: After breakfast and hotel check-out, our morning excursion takes us to the Valley of Fire, Nevada’s oldest State Park. The rough floor and jagged walls of the park contain brilliant formations of eroded sandstone and sand dunes more than 150 million years old. These features, which are the centerpiece of the park’s attractions, often appear to be on fire when reflecting the sun’s rays. After a stop for lunch (*on our own*), we will drive to Las Vegas to drop off our luggage at our hotel. Next, we will visit the Lake Mead National Recreation Area to see this beautiful spot created by the construction of the Hoover Dam and tour the magnificent dam to learn about its construction and history. Return to Las Vegas for check-in at the *Tropicana Resort & Casino* (or similar) conveniently located at the hottest four corners on the world-famous Las Vegas Strip for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

DAY 7 – LAS VEGAS: Breakfast at our hotel. Today is a full-day at leisure to enjoy some of the city’s most famous casinos, or maybe visit one of the most visual spots in Las Vegas –The Fremont Street Experience! This canopied five blocks of the downtown is an eclectic collections of shops, boutiques, 10 casinos, 63 restaurants and more, surrounded by the brilliance of 12 million LED lights, and the music and special effects of 220 speakers generating 550,000 watts. Or catch a Las Vegas show at one of the many wonderful hotel complexes! Dinner is on our own. Return to our hotel for overnight. (BB)

To ENROLL: Submit a signed application and deposit of \$300 per person. This deposit amount does not include the optional non-refundable insurance premium for your trip which you should add to the trip deposit with your initial payment. Please note that the insurance premium will be applied against the initial amount you deposit unless you decline the insurance coverage, in writing, by checking off the appropriate "opt out" section on your enrollment form. Full payment for the trip is due 75 days before departure. If reservation is made on or after 75 days, full payment must be submitted.

REQUIRED IDENTIFICATION on motor coach trips to Canada: All U.S. Citizens on this trip must carry either a valid U.S. Passport or the New North American Travel Card I.D. Non U.S. Citizens must check with both the Canadian and U.S. Immigration Authorities to determine documentation requirements for the trip. CLEARLY PRINT your name on the trip enrollment form as it appears (or will appear) on the documentation you will use. Check the confirmation and travel documents that you receive from THE Travel Authority, Inc. Contact THE Travel Authority, Inc. immediately to advise of any errors. THE Travel Authority, Inc. will not be responsible for any losses or damages incurred as a result of denied or delayed border crossings or any tour component(s) missed as a result of inadequate or missing identification as deemed by Immigration/Border Crossing Authorities.

REQUIRED IDENTIFICATION on motor coach trips entirely within the U.S. A government issued photo I.D. should be carried at all times. Some of the places visited (such as Museums, Military Installations, Casinos, Hotels) require such identification. THE Travel Authority, Inc. will not be responsible for any losses or damages incurred as a result of inadequate identification.

CANCELLATION CHARGES & REFUND POLICY: You have the right to cancel your trip. If you cancel your trip for any reason, the following per person cancellation charges will be assessed. These charges are in no way punitive and include Agency Administrative Charges. If written notice of cancellation is received by THE Travel Authority, Inc. . . .

If THE Travel Authority, Inc. does not receive a Tour Member's full payment on or before due date, the reservation of the Tour Member may be deemed canceled at the sole discretion of THE Travel Authority, Inc. In such instance, the cancellation provisions detailed above will apply with the date of cancellation being deemed the date on which payment was past due. As no exceptions shall be made on the cancellation charges, participants are strongly urged to purchase Trip Cancellation Protection.
