Our Italian Itinerary:

DAY 1 – DEPART TO ITALY: Board our transatlantic flight to Italy, with full meal and beverage service, while in-flight.

DAY 2 – FLORENCE/PISA - MONTECATINI SPA: *"Benvenuti in Italia" - Welcome to Italy!* At the airport in Florence/Pisa, our Tour Escort will be waiting to help us with our transfer. Board our motorcoach for the drive to the 4-star *Hotel Manzoni* (or similar) in Montecatini for check-in. The remainder of the day is at leisure to familiarize ourselves with our surroundings prior to our "Welcome Dinner" and orientation meeting at the hotel this evening. (D) *Hotel website: www.hotelmanzoni.info* (D)

DAY 3 – FLORENCE: After breakfast, there will be a morning sightseeing tour of Florence. We will visit the beautiful Piazza Del Duomo to see the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, Giotto's Bell Tower, and the Romanesque Baptistery of St. John. Later, we will visit the Academia Museum to view Michelangelo's most famous sculpture, "The David". The afternoon at leisure for individual sightseeing and shopping. Return to our hotel in Montecatini for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

DAY 4 – VENICE: After breakfast, there will be a morning sightseeing tour of Venice. This walking tour will begin in Piazza San Marco where there are many galleries, shops, and charming cafés. We will also visit the Doge's Palace and cross the Bridge of Sighs which connects to the Piombi Prisons. There will be a full luncheon at a restaurant in Venice, followed by some free time this afternoon for individual sightseeing and last minute shopping. On our way back to Montecatini, we will be served a deli boxed dinner aboard our motorcoach. Overnight (BB, L, BD)

DAY 5 – SIENA-SAN GIMIGNANO: After breakfast, we depart for Siena. We will drive southwest through the heart of Italian wine country, over the rolling hills of Chianti. Once in Siena, our escort will lead us to Piazza del Campo, through the narrow streets, past Medieval towers and walls. One of the notable highlights of Siena is San Domenico, which holds the relics of St. Catherine, the patron saint of Italy. We will next visit San Gimignano, often described as *"The most famous small town in Italy."* This charming Medieval hilltop town is noted for its many towers and its breathtaking views of the Tuscan landscape. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Montecatini. (BB, D)

DAY 6 – MONTECATINI-ASSISI-ROME: Following breakfast, we will depart for Rome, with a stop in Assisi to view the Basilica of St. Francis and have some free time to browse the city. Enjoy the beautiful countryside with lunch (*on our own*) en route to "The Eternal City". Upon arrival in Rome, we will check-in at the 4-star *Hotel Diana* (or similar). There will be time to rest, relax, shop, and freshen-up. Our group will gather for dinner this evening. Overnight. *Hotel website: www.hoteldianaroma.com/en/* (BB, D)

DAY 7 – ANCIENT & MODERN ROME: Breakfast at our hotel, followed by a day-long city sightseeing tour. In the morning, we will have our "Ancient Rome" tour, featuring the famous monuments and landmarks of Rome. In the afternoon, following time for lunch (*on our own*), we will meet up for a tour of Modern Rome. By the time our day winds to a close, we will have seen the Colosseum, the Pantheon, the Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain, and so much more! Back to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

DAY 8 – VATICAN CITY-ROME: After breakfast, we will visit St. Peter's Basilica and the Sistine Chapel. Raise your eyes to see Michelangelo's *"Creation"* and the famous *"Last Judgement"*. Lunch is on our own. The afternoon is at leisure for shopping-and-browsing or exploring on our own. Dinner at the hotel that evening. (BB, D)

DAY 9 - ROME TO HOME: After breakfast, we will depart our hotel and be transferred to the airport in Rome where we will board our return flight, with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in-flight. (BB)

TO BOOK A TRIP a signed enrollment form & deposit of \$300. per person is required. In addition the non-refundable insurance premium, which is not included in the trip price, should be added to the deposit amount, unless you opt out (choose not to purchase) the insurance in writing on this enrollment form. Payment in full is due 95 days prior to departure

REQUIRED IDENTIFICATION: All U.S. Citizens must carry a valid U.S. Passport. Many countries require that the expiration date of the Passport must be six months or more after the return date of the trip you are booking. It is the responsibility of non U.S. Citizens to contact the Immigration authorities of all countries being visited and the U. S. to determine their documentation requirements. You will be denied boarding without the required identification. THE Travel Authority, Inc. and its Agents will not be responsible for any expenses and/or damages incurred as a result of such denied or delayed boarding or passage at the border.

CANCELLATION CHARGES & REFUND POLICY: You have the right to cancel your trip. If you cancel your trip for any reason the following cancellation charges will be assessed per person. These charges are in no way punitive and include Agency Administrative Charges. If written notice of cancellation is received by THE Travel Authority, Inc....

On or before 96 days.....\$150 per person* (plus non-refundable insurance premium)

From 95 to 76 days.....50% of total trip per person* (plus non-refundable insurance premium)

75 days or less.....(including "no-shows") 100% of total trip price per person* (plus non-refundable insurance premium)

If THE Travel Authority, Inc. issues or causes to have issued airline tickets for the trip you book, the price of that ticket, once issued will be added to the cancellation charges itemized above.

*In the event a cancellation causes an additional cost (single room supplement, etc.) for a person(s) still going on the trip, the canceling party shall have that additional charge added to the cancellation charges itemized above. If you cancel, to receive any refund, you must return all travel documents including air and/or cruise tickets to THE Travel Authority. Refund will be processed 30 days after receipt of your written cancellation and aforementioned documents. Written notice of cancellation (and travel documents, if applicable, must be sent to THE TRAVEL AUTHORITY, INC., P.O. Box 254, Bensalem PA 19020. Date of cancellation shall be determined by the date on which such written notification is received by THE Travel Authority, Inc.. Telephoned or other non-written communication to THE Travel Authority, Inc. will not constitute notice of cancellation. If a tour member's full payment is not received by THE Travel Authority, Inc. on or before due date, the reservation of the Tour Member may be deemed canceled at the sole discretion of THE Travel Authority, Inc.. In such instance, the cancellation provisions detailed above will apply with the date of cancellation being deemed the date at which payment was past due.
