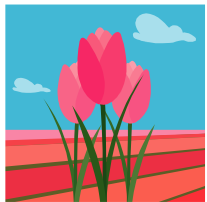


OTTOWA TULIP FESTIVAL & 1000 ISLANDS

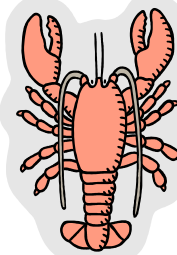
LOBSTERFEST, MUSIKFEST ADVENTURE & MOHEGAN SUN CASINO at POCONO DOWNS
