Itinerary

DAY 1 - USA -NAPLES: Depart International Airport on an overnight transatlantic Alitalia flight to Naples Enjoy a delicious dinner on board with complimentary beverages followed by a relaxing movie, including free headsets.

DAY 2 – NAPLES-SORRENTO: Continental breakfast served on board the flight. Arrival at the airport in Naples where we will be met by our Tour Escort and transferred to the 4-star *Hotel Michelangelo* (or similar) in Sorrento. *Website: www.michelangelohotel.it* Pizza lunch at our hotel today is included. The remainder of the day is at our leisure to get acquainted with the hotel and our surroundings. An orientation meeting, with “Welcoming Drink”, this evening at our hotel prior to dinner. Overnight. (L, D)

DAY 3 – SORRENTO: After breakfast at our hotel, we will be hosted on a morning walk through the historical center of Sorrento, including a visit to the Museum of Correale which is situated in the 18th century palazzo at the east end of town. Then we will be taken on a morning tour through the hillsides of Sorrento, where wild roses and camellias surround us. We will visit *La Sorgente*, a picturesque agricultural farm, belonging to the family *Marciano* which is nestled in the Sorrentine hills with a fabulous view of the city of Naples. Sip on homemade wine, snack on crisp, tender Italian bread (topped with fresh tomato and a drizzle of olive oil), and sample the best homemade mozzarella one could imagine! And we will experience a demonstration of making mozzarella - the old fashioned way! We will return to the hotel for lunch. The afternoon is at leisure for optional tours. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (BB, L, D)

DAY 4 – ISLE OF CAPRI: Today we will visit the beautiful Isle of Capri! Our full-day excursion includes a round trip ferry ride, lunch on Capri, and a guided tour. The town of Capri is very chic with shops, hotels, and restaurants lying along winding streets. The main square - Piazza Umberto - has a pretty white church and several open-air cafes where you can sit and watch the world go by. We'll also visit the Augustus Gardens and their magnificent view over the Faraglioni Rocks. Return to our hotel on the mainland via ferry for dinner this evening. (BB, L, D)

DAY 5 - AMALFI DRIVE: After breakfast at the hotel, we will be taken on an excursion along one of the most scenic roads in the world – *The Amalfi Drive!* Our first stop will be above Positano, one of Italy's most famous and elegant resorts. We will then continue our drive through the ancient marine republic of Amalfi. There will be some free time to visit the beautiful Cathedral of St. Andrew, explore the town or browse and shop. Lunch will be in the town of Scala, and in the afternoon we will visit Ravello. Return to Sorrento for dinner and overnight. (BB, L, D)

DAY 6 – POMPEII-NAPLES: Following breakfast, we will visit the “lost city” of Pompeii and its excavations. Lunch in Pompeii. Afterwards, we will tour the city of Naples, visiting the commercial and military port, and the medieval castle, Castel dell'Ovo. Dinner and overnight in Sorrento. (BB, L, D)

DAY 7 – CASERTA-MONTECASSINO: After breakfast, drive to Caserta for a tour of the imposing Royal Palace (*built by Charles IV to rival the Palace of Versailles*) and the magnificent grounds and gardens. After lunch, we are off to the famous hilltop Abbey of Montecassino, which was destroyed during one of the most brutal battles of WWII, and subsequently re-built in the 1950's. Dinner and overnight at in Sorrento. (BB, L, D)

DAY 8 – SORRENTO: Breakfast at our hotel. The day is at complete leisure! Lunch at our hotel. “Farewell Dinner” at a typical restaurant in the heart of Sorrento, with live Neapolitan music and dancing. Overnight. (BB, L, D)

DAY 9 – SORRENTO-NAPLES-ROME-USA: After breakfast and hotel check-out, transfer to the Naples Airport for our return Alitalia flight home with full meal and beverage service en route. We will arrive back the same day. (BB)

TO BOOK A TRIP a signed enrollment form & deposit of \$300. per person is required. Payment in full is due 95 days prior to departure.

REQUIRED IDENTIFICATION: All U.S. Citizens must carry a valid U.S. Passport. Many countries require that the expiration date of the Passport must be six months or more after the return date of the trip you are booking. It is the responsibility of non U.S. Citizens to contact the Immigration authorities of all countries being visited and the U. S. to determine their documentation requirements. You will be denied boarding without the required identification. THE Travel Authority, Inc. and its Agents will not be responsible for any expenses and/or damages incurred as a result of such denied or delayed boarding or passage at the border.

CANCELLATION CHARGES & REFUND POLICY: You have the right to cancel your trip. If you cancel your trip for any reason the following cancellation charges will be assessed per person. These charges are in no way punitive and include Agency Administrative Charges. If written notice of cancellation is received by THE Travel Authority, Inc....

On or before 96 days.....\$150 per person* (plus non-refundable insurance premium)

From 95 to 76 days.....50% of total trip per person* (plus non-refundable insurance premium)

75 days or less.....(including "no-shows") 100% of total trip price per person* (plus non-refundable insurance premium)

If THE Travel Authority, Inc. issues or causes to have issued airline tickets for the trip you book, the price of that ticket, once issued will be added to the cancellation charges itemized above.

*In the event a cancellation causes an additional cost (single room supplement, etc.) for a person(s) still going on the trip, the canceling party shall have that additional charge added to the cancellation charges itemized above. If you cancel, to receive any refund, you must return all travel documents including air and/or cruise tickets to THE Travel Authority. Refund will be processed 30 days after receipt of your written cancellation and aforementioned documents. Written notice of cancellation (and travel documents, if applicable, must be sent to THE TRAVEL AUTHORITY, INC., P.O. Box 254, Bensalem PA 19020. Date of cancellation shall be determined by the date on which such written notification is received by THE Travel Authority, Inc.. Telephoned or other non-written communication to THE Travel Authority, Inc. will not constitute notice of cancellation. If a tour member's full payment is not received by THE Travel Authority, Inc. on or before due date, the reservation of the Tour Member may be deemed canceled at the sole discretion of THE Travel Authority, Inc.. In such instance, the cancellation provisions detailed above will apply with the date of cancellation being deemed the date at which payment was past due.
